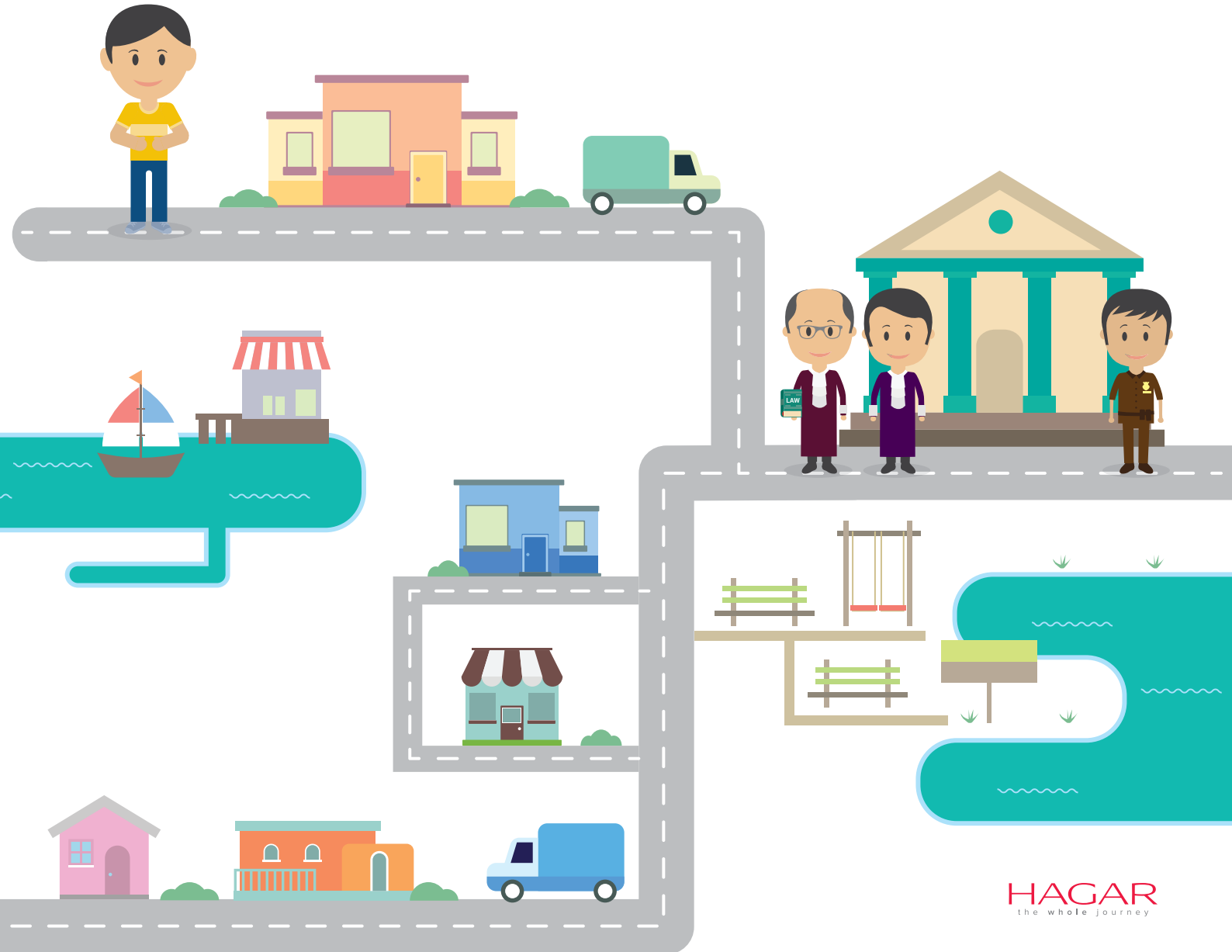
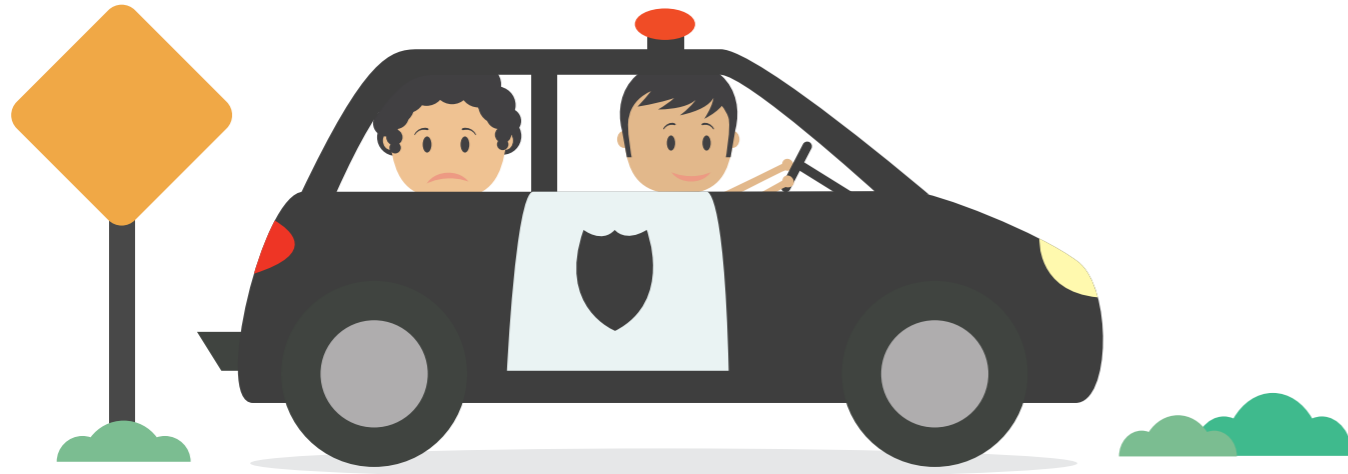


# Bona Goes To Court



# Bona Goes To Court



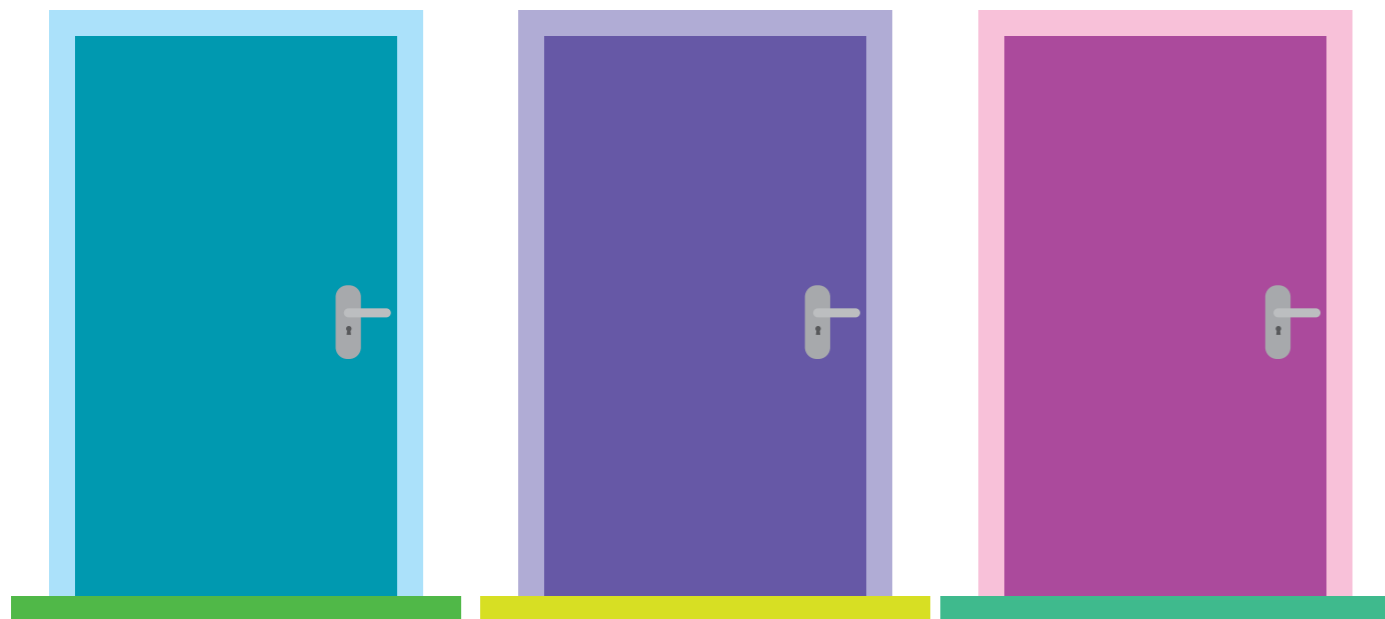
Something terrible happened to Bona. The police looked into the matter to find out what happened and whether someone had broken the law.

Now Bona is going to court so that he can tell the judges what happened. Just like you!

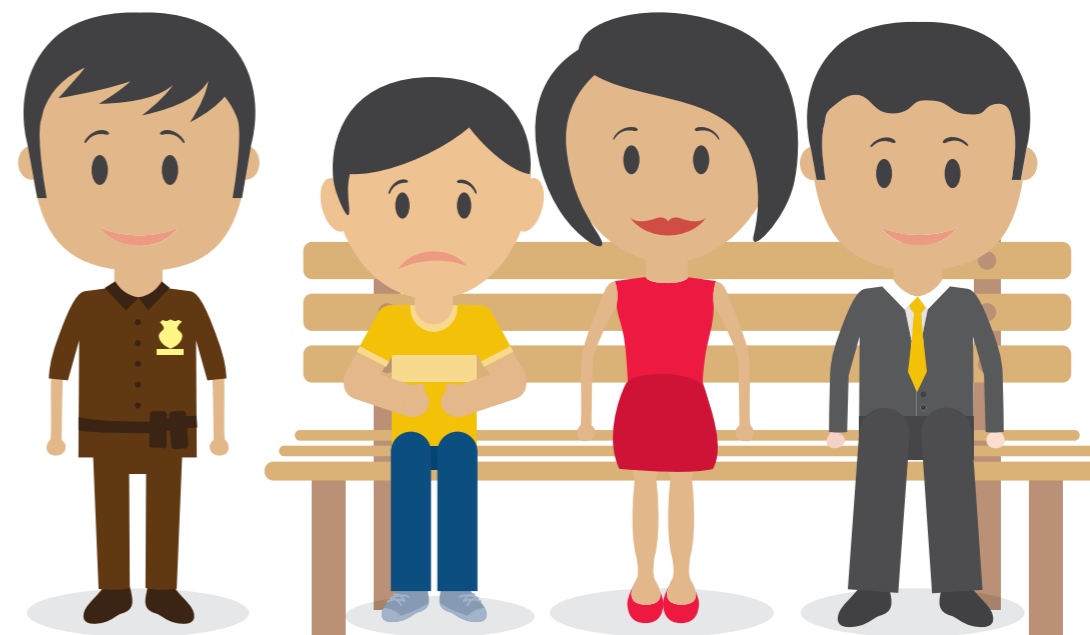


Bona is a bit scared because he has never been to court before. Can you draw how you are feeling?

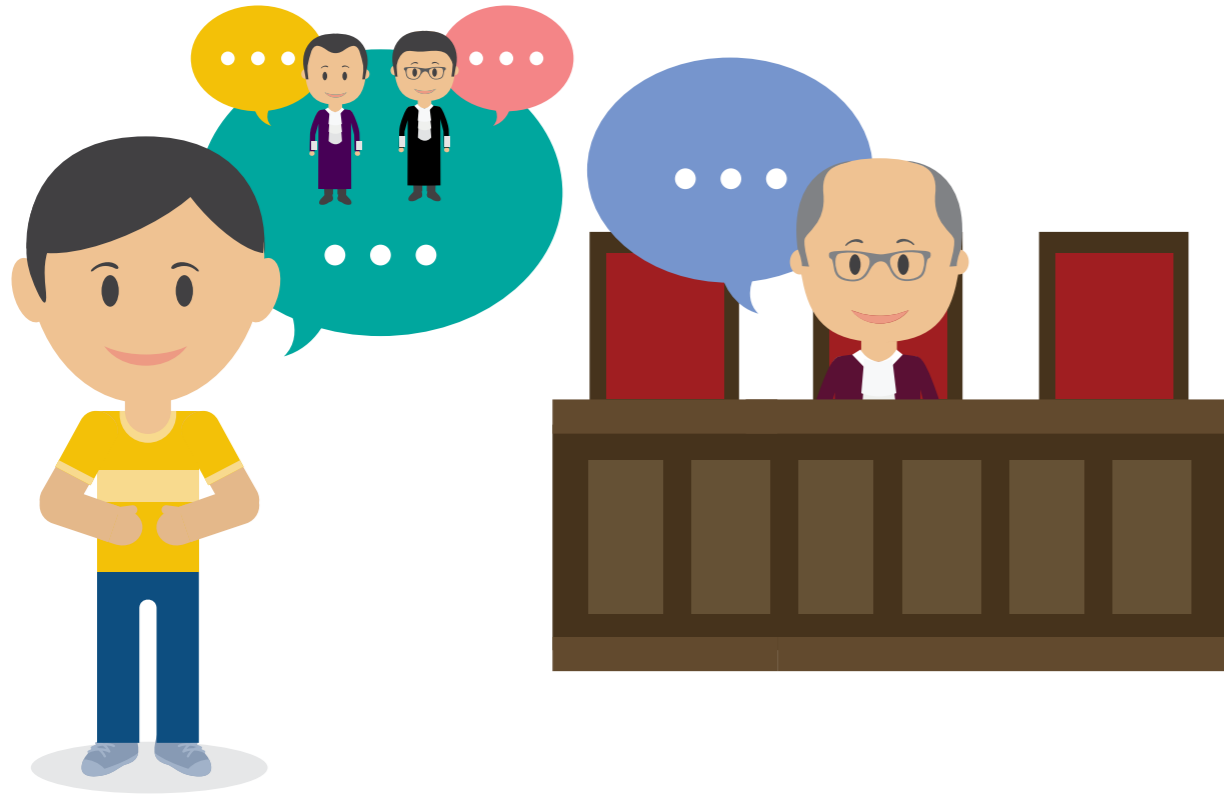
But then Bona remembered that there are lots of people to help him through it. These people will keep Bona safe.



A courthouse is a big building with lots of rooms. Bona will be going into one of the rooms, where the judge and some other people will be talking about the case.

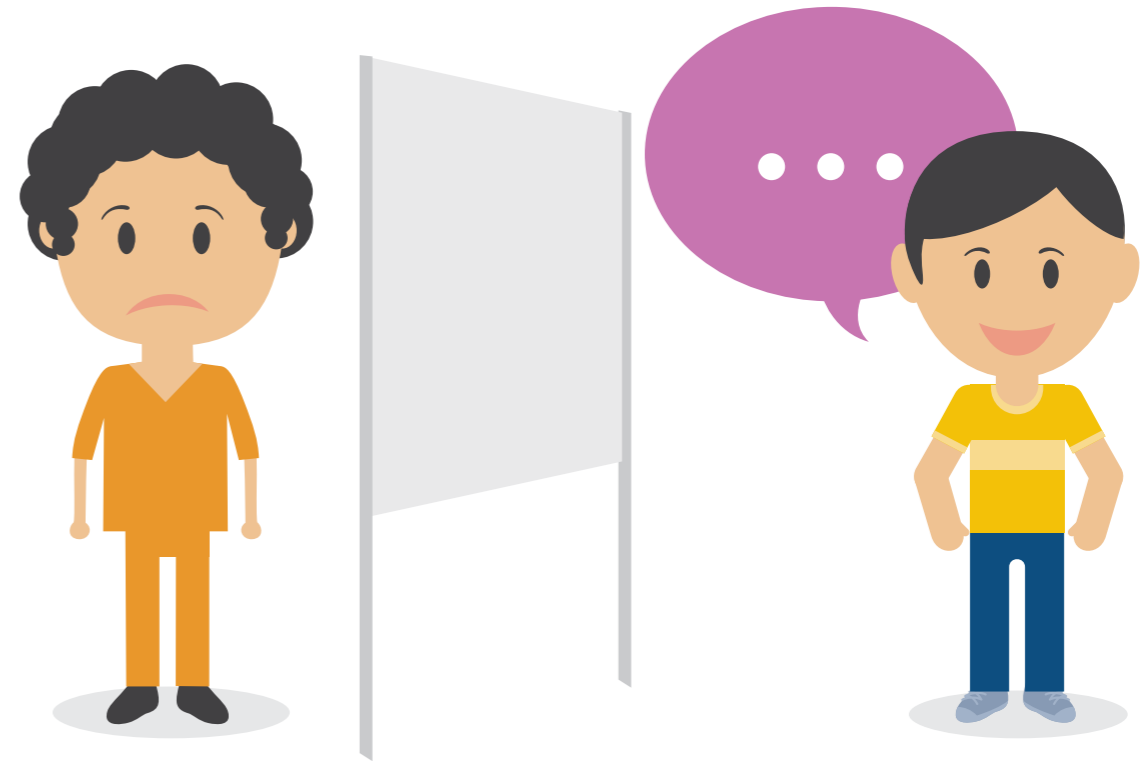

Bona was then brought into the courtroom so that the judges, Prosecutor and the lawyers could ask him questions about what happened.

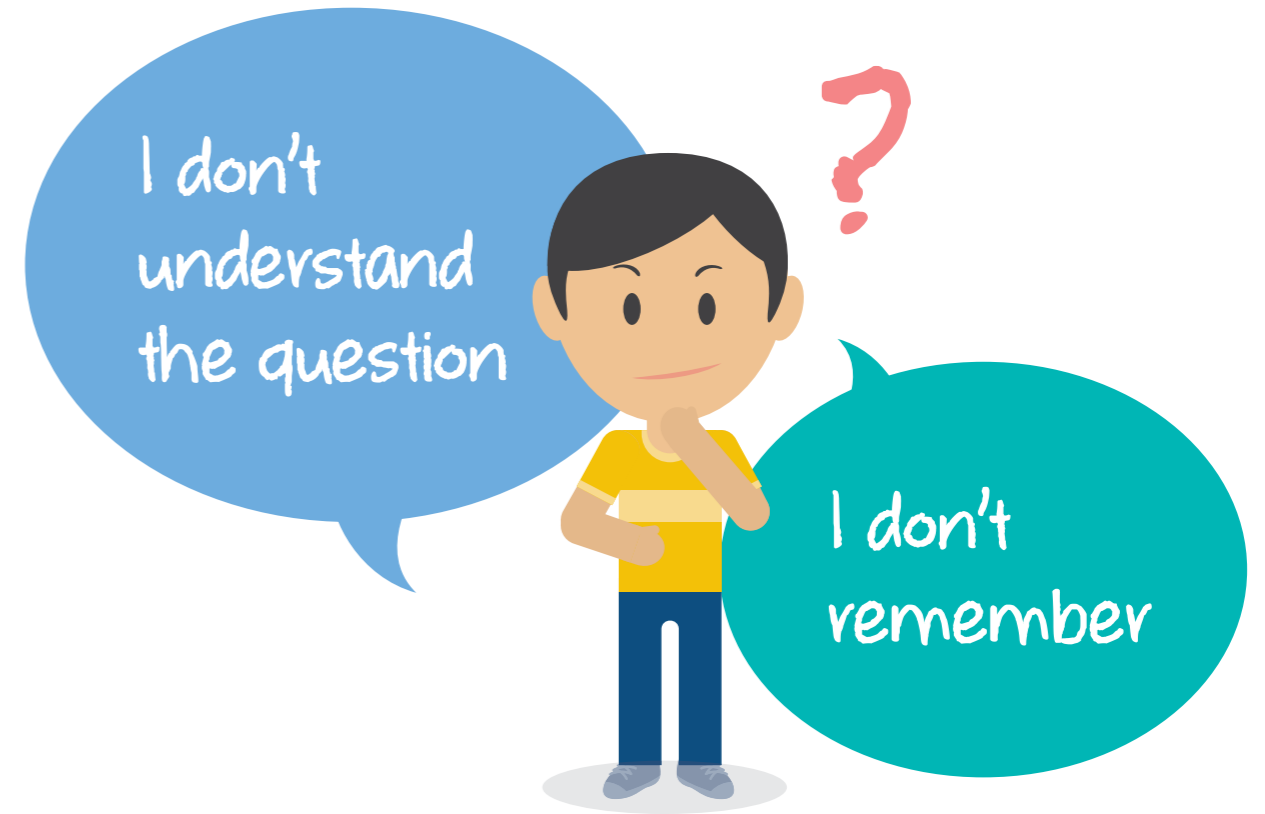

Then it was finished! Bona had done a very important job by answering the questions truthfully.

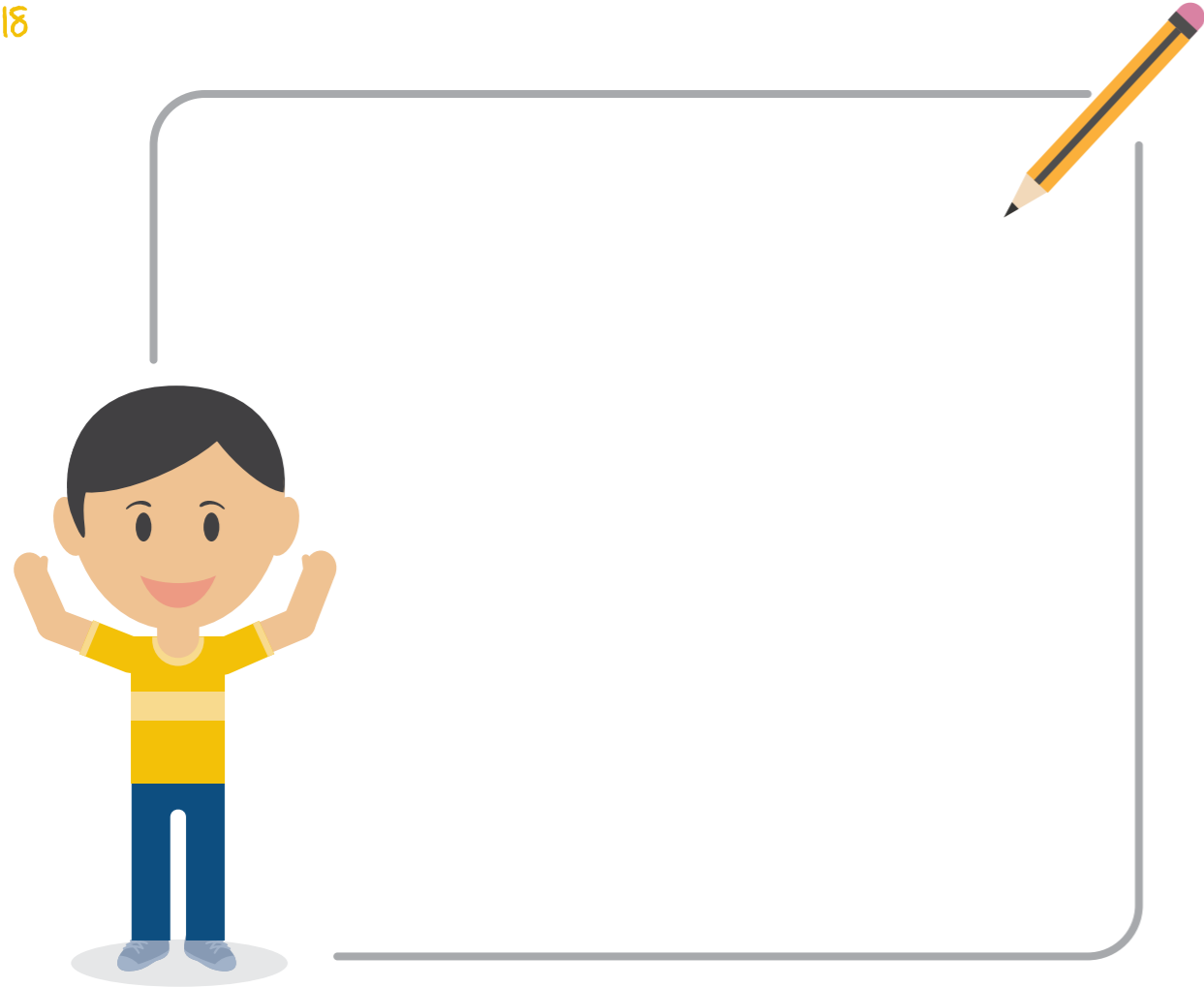




After the court hearing, the judges thought about all the things that they heard in the courtroom.
